Nested copy of work items with children

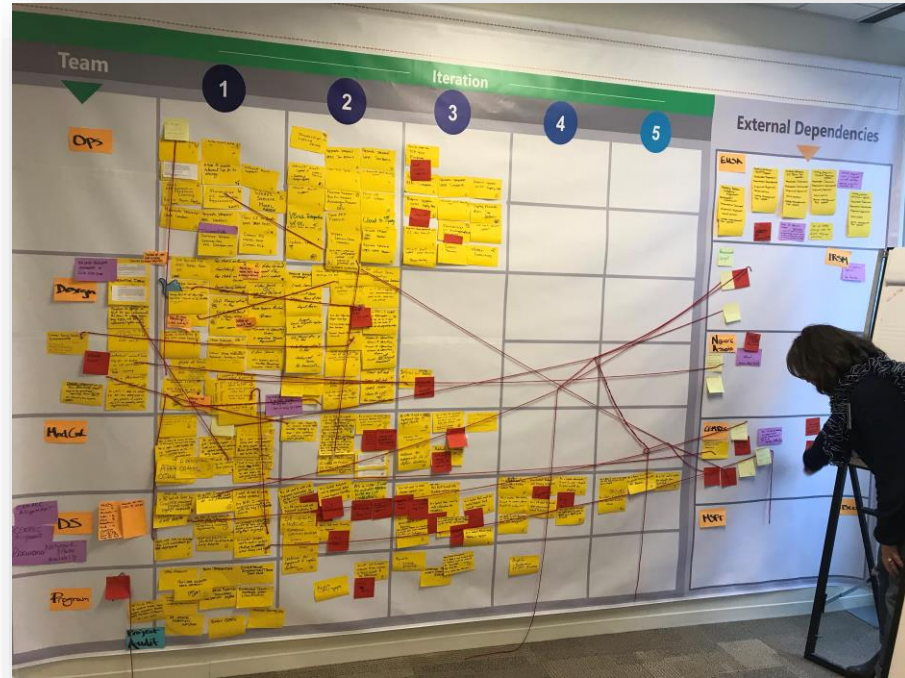
SAFe® Updates

Updates in the RTC templates for SAFe 4.5

Program Board

A board that **visualizes and tracks dependencies** among teams and with other ARTs across PIs.

- Shows the new feature delivery dates and relevant Milestones.
- Facilitates reviewing items in the 'implementing' state, including discussion of dependencies and execution.



Visualize plan dependencies across teams

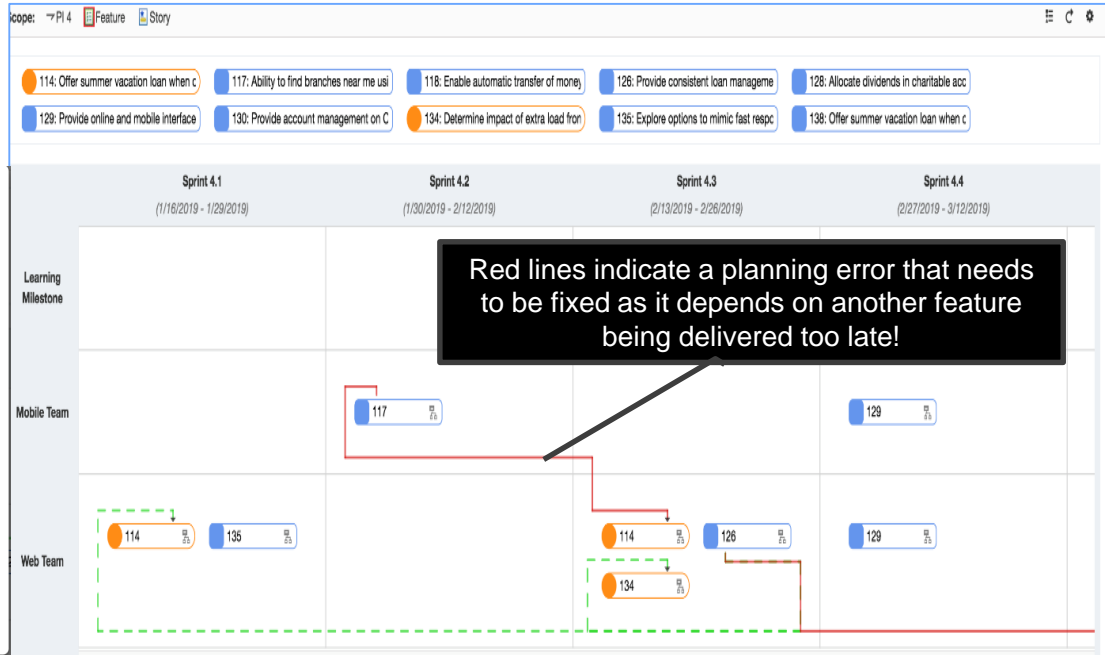
Actionable, not just a pretty picture



View children and dependencies combined into a single menu action.

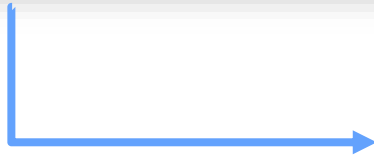

SAFe 4.5 template updates



Data Types

Renamed *PI Objective Type* to *Scope* so that it more adequately describes generic scope for use in multiple work item types

Work Item Types

PI Objective: Renamed **PI Objective Type** attribute to **Scope**

Risk: Added **Scope** attribute, updated editors

Program Epic, Feature: Updated workflow to include additional transitions

Plan Updates

Added **Scope, Risk Category, Probability, Impact, Exposure (%)** as plan attributes

Added **Scope** as grouping attribute

Removed **PI Objective Type** as plan attribute
